John is Jesus' disciple who seems to be, more than almost any other disciple, enraptured by the love and grace of Jesus Christ. In his gospel, we see a unique emphasis on the love of Jesus for His people, as can be seen in chapters 13-16. However, John also wrote epistles. As he writes his gospel account under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, he writes "that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in His name" (John 20:31). As he writes his epistles, he writes "that you may know that you have eternal life" (1 John 5:13). John wants us to believe and cling to Jesus everyday (his gospel account), but he also wants us to have certainty that we are believing in Jesus (his epistles). It is one thing to believe in Him; it is another thing to know that we believe in Him. Thus, John's epistle lays out 8 different "marks of grace" in 1 John. He is basically saying, "if you have truly believed in Jesus, these are the kinds of fruits you will see in your life." Though no Christian will have all of these fruits perfectly like the Lord Jesus, they will really and truly have them in some measure. As you read of John's amazement with Jesus, ask yourself if you are the kind of follower of Jesus that he describes in his epistles, for this is the true follower of Jesus.
