
This month we are reading through what are called "post-exilic" books. This means that these books are God's inspired stories of what happened after God's people returned from their exile to the land that God had promised them. Because Israel and Judah had broken the covenant that they made with God through their idolatry and unrighteousness, God punished them just as He said He would in Deuteronomy 28. God sent them out of the land of promise so that they might see their sin clearly, and then turn to Him in repentance and faith, trusting that He would remember His promises to bring them back into the land again. Just as God declared He would do, He did not forget them. In fact, God had declared beforehand that He would raise up a foreign king (Cyrus) who would bring them back into the land (see Isaiah 44:28-45:1). Yet in the end, Israel is left waiting for the day when God will truly dwell with His people (Rev. 21-22), for they are still unfaithful to God and need forgiveness for their sins through Jesus Christ.
