
God's word tells us that all of the Bible is for our use as Christians (2 Tim. 3:16), because ultimately all of the Bible is about Jesus (Luke 24:27). Though we often refuse to believe God's word concerning the "meticulous" and "boring" parts of the OT (like Leviticus), God does not think that His word is boring nor unable to correct us or stir worship in us. The entire New Testament is built upon what God had already revealed in the OT. Therefore, we cannot make sense of the NT without knowing the OT! We are finishing what we started last month: Leviticus and Hebrews. As the Hebrew Christians were considering going back to the OT way of worship (as outlined in Leviticus), the author of the Hebrews tells them that all of that old sacrificial system has been fulfilled in Jesus Christ—He is what it was pointing to all along! Since God requires that we worship Him in the way that He has commanded us to (seen in Lev. 10), they (and we) can only approach Him by faith in Jesus Christ. How do you see this in these books?
