
D6: November 2022: HS

As we continue through the book of Isaiah in this month, we will get to read some of the most sacred and precious chapters of the most sacred and precious book in the whole earth! There are some who have called Isaiah a "fifth gospel" (the other four are Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John) because of how Christ-centered this part of Isaiah is. In chapters 40 through the end of the book, Isaiah speaks to future Israel, who has received punishment for their sins. He speaks to a people who have been kicked out of the land, who have been forsaken by God. He speaks to them of a coming day when God shall again be gracious to them, when He shall forgive them, when He shall renew their strength. All of this will happen when God's Servant, the Lord Jesus Christ, comes and dies for the sake of His people only to be resurrected from the grave. As you read the book of Isaiah this week, see the promises made to Israel and trust that they can be promises to you particularly through faith alone in Jesus Christ. What a marvel!
