
D6: March 2023: HS

This month we will look at two movements in the life of Israel. First, we will finish up Jeremiah and move through the book of Lamentations. This book is one that has much to teach us today, as it is really a book about suffering. The book is written after God has punished His people and brought them into the yoke of slavery to other nations. The question then arises: has God forgotten His people? Does their suffering show that He doesn't care about them (the psalms listed cover the same questions)? Not at all! The theme of the book is placed right in the center of it: "The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases; his mercies never come to an end" (3:22). We will then begin to look at Ezekiel, who is a prophet of the death and resurrection. The first half of the book of Ezekiel, similarly to Jeremiah, is where he declares the coming death of the people of Israel on account of their sin. What stands out in an amazing way is in the first few chapters when Ezekiel meets with the living God. He is brought low and lifted up only by
