

D6: February 2024 Middle School

This month we are learning about real relationships. Each week we will be reading about different relationships in our own life and different Bible stories that go along with them. Use a journal as you read this month. Each **Day** after you read, try to summarize the passage in a few sentences. For each **Week** ask yourself these questions: **Week 1: FAMILY**, How does Joseph treat his brothers at the end of the story? Would you have done the same or differently? Why? **Week 2: FRIENDS**, What do these two stories show you about good friends? What is one characteristic of being a godly friend from each story that you need to improve in your own life? **Week 3: AUTHORITY**, Who was Esther's authority in this story? Was she disrespectful or respectful towards that authority? How does Esther respond when the authority in her life goes against God? **Week 4: GOD**, Job's relationship with God in this story is kind of like a roller coaster. What is an example of a time that like Job, you were faithful to God through hardship? What is an example of a time when you, also like Job, questioned, doubted or became angry with God? When God replies to Job in Chapters 38-40, read it like He is talking directly to you. How does that make you feel?
