D6: June 2025: Middle School

This month we will look at 2 different books. Deuteronomy is Moses' final words to the nation of Israel. He tells them to be faithful to their covenant with God by listening to and loving Him. Hebrews is a letter to a group of believers who are being persecuted for their faith. The author reminds them that Jesus is greater than anything else and He is worthy of all their trust and devotion. He encourages and challenges them to remain faithful to Jesus, even in their trials. Hebrews also makes connections between the Old Covenant mentioned in Deuteronomy, and the New Covenant which was established through Jesus Christ.

As you go through the reading each day write down your answer to these questions: What did this passage teach you about God? What did it teach you about yourself? How did you see the Gospel in this passage? Were there any commands given for how you should live? What is something new you learned through this passage?
