

## Introduction

This month we are going all the way back to the beginning and we will learn about the creation of everything! The book of Genesis was written by Moses and it is a description of the very beginning of the world when God created everything all the way to Joseph becoming a slave in Egypt. In this book, we learn about God's power as well as His love for His people. We also see many stories of people choosing sin over obeying God. Sometimes when we read stories about people making big mistakes, we can judge them and think "Well, I would never do that."

But the reality of being a sinful person in a sinful world is that we are usually the ones making those big, sinful mistakes. But as we study Genesis, we will see that we serve a God who is patient and merciful toward us. He is willing to forgive us if we repent (turn away from our sin) and follow Jesus.

As you go through the reading each day write down your answer to these questions: What did this passage teach you about God? What did it teach you about humanity? Did you see the gospel in this passage? Were there any commands given for how you should live? What is something new you learned through this passage?

## Weekly Assignment

Each week, come up with one question that you have from that week's reading. Once you have written down that question go and ask it to a parent, grandparent, small group leader, or any other trustworthy adult in your life.

## Memory Challenge

**Question:** What is our only hope in life and death?

**Answer:** That we are not our own but belong, body and soul, both in life and death, to God and to our Savior Jesus Christ.

**Passage:** Romans 14: 7-8

"For none of us lives to himself, and none of us dies to himself. For if we live, we live in the Lord, and if we die, we die to the Lord. So then, whether we live or whether we die, we are the Lord's."
