Introduction

Jesus asks a powerful question of his disciples; "But who do you say that I am?" In the Gospels, we get the answer to this question; we get to know Jesus as he reveals himself to us. As we dig into the Gospels, we get to walk away with an answer to the question of who Jesus is - along with Peter we can declare "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God" (Matthew 16:15).

This Fall, we will be reading through the Gospels twice, learning about the life and ministry of Jesus here on earth. Sometimes the Gospel stories can feel very familiar to us but as we read, we want to slow down and ponder who Jesus is, what he did, and who we are called to be as his followers. Our hope is that by spending time in the same books, you'll be able to gain a deeper understanding of who Jesus is and the way he lived.

While You Read

For September/October, read the Gospels in whatever translation you normally read from. For November/December (our second read through of the Gospels), we will have you choose a different translation to read from.

As you read, **make a list of who Jesus is in the Gospels** - the names of Jesus, how he is described, what he did, etc. Every day you read, add to this list by writing down anything that you learn about who Jesus is in those chapters. Keep the question that Jesus asked his disciples in the back of your mind as you read - "But who do you say I am?"

At the end of the month, read back over your list, then share with your parent, small group leader, or another trusted adult, what was something that stood out to you about who Jesus is in the Gospels.
