This month, we will read the first half of the book of Exodus. This book begins where Genesis ends and depicts the Israelites living in Egypt. But quickly everything will change! Exodus is an exciting book about God's people being delivered from slavery and beginning their journey toward the promised land. We learn about God's provision for His people and that, when God saves us, we enter into a new kind of relationship with Him.
