

Introduction

“In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth”- Gen 1:1. This is a verse that we all know and have probably heard many times. It’s easy to just brush past this and gravitate towards stories like the ones in the gospels. But Genesis holds so many rich truths about God and Christianity and it’s important that we take the time to dig in and explore these stories too.

This month we will be reading through the book of Genesis, learning about key beliefs in Christianity including Creation and The Fall. We will also see examples of God’s sovereignty and grace amidst humanity’s brokenness. Some of these stories will probably be familiar to you and others may be new. But our hope is that you would be able to slow down and see God in each story and learn more about who He is and who He says we are.

While You Read

Read each chapter slowly and carefully. Underline, highlight or mark anything that stands out to you. Remember that this book holds so many truths that are foundational to our faith. As you read, **take note of things that surprised or confused you or that you hadn’t noticed before.** Also look for how you can apply what you read to your own life.

Take time after you read to journal and reflect on what you learned. **Write down any questions you have or things that you want to learn more about.** Then find a time to talk to a parent, small group leader, or pastor about those things.
